Our portfolio of venues are the Connaught Theatre, Studio and Cinema, the Pavilion Theatre and Atrium, the Assembly Hall and Worthing Museum. We bring the very best theatre, music, dance, circus, talks, family work, comedy, exhibitions, film and education opportunities to our community. The Pavilion Theatre and Atrium is on the beautiful Worthing seafront in front of the Pier. With a short walk up Chapel Road you'll find many restaurants, cafes and shops. Continue on and you'll come to the Connaught Cinema and Studio on the right. Almost opposite is the Worthing Museum and Gallery. The Museum is currently closed to connect to the Worthing Heat Network initiative, due to reopen in Winter 2025. If you continue up Chapel Road past the Museum then take a left onto Stoke Abbott Road you'll find the Assembly Hall.

WTM offers a wide selection of live events, from the latest film releases at the Connaught, to our Summer of Circus season which includes free outdoor Circus on selected weekends throughout the summer as well as indoor ticketed shows.
